Snack Pak 4 Kids Expands Weekend Snack for Children to Include Shelf-Stable Milk

S nack Pak 4 Kids (SP4K) is excited to announce that weekend snack packs that it provides to more than 3,000 food-insecure children in nine Texas Panhandle school districts will now include shelf-stable milk. The addition is made possible through the support of Elanco Animal Health and Southwest Dairy Farmers.

Southwest Potato Corn Chowder

Ingredients

2 tablespoons Butter
1/2 cup finely chopped onion
1/2 cup finely chopped red bell pepper
1 clove garlic, minced
1/4 cup Butter
1/4 cup all-purpose flour
1/2 teaspoon ground cumin
1/4 teaspoon ground white pepper
2 cups Half-and-Half
2 cups chicken broth
1 teaspoon dried chives
2 cups frozen Southern Style has brown potatoes thawed
1 (11 oz) can Mexican-style corn, drained
2 cups grated Pepper Jack Cheese

Preparation Instructions In a large stockpot over medium-high heat, melt 2 tbsp. butter; saute onion and red bell pepper in melted butter until tender, about 5 minutes. Add 1/4

c. butter and garlic to pot and stir until butter is melted. Reduce heat to medium, add flour, ground cumin and white pepper; cook for 3 minutes, stirring constantly. Stir in the half and half; bring to a simmer, and cook, stirring occasionally, until mixture is thickened. Slowly add chicken broth and simmer for 5 minutes. Add the chives, potatoes and corn; reduce heat to low and simmer for 10 minutes. Add the grated cheese, and stir until melted *Recipe by: Kitchen Kimberley*
